Class Descriptions

Electives

Tutoring: Need support with homework? Sign up for a tutor and meet with them during this time to get your homework done or you can just work on your own using our computers to complete assignments.

Girls Ink- Newsletter: Do you like writing? This newspaper class will engage girls in the process of researching stories, creating content and publishing original work. This class will create a Girls Inc. Newsletter that will be given out to members, parents and staff.

Sports: As a group, girls will choose between Basketball, Volleyball, and Soccer, learn the fundamentals of the game and scrimmage against each other.

Middle School

Girls Group: A series of workshops designed especially for girls to address everyday life and unique issues affecting teens. The topics may include Body Image, Healthy Relationships and Dating and many others of your choice.

High School

Mi Avenida: *A college prep program.* Girls will discover their values and goals giving them tools they need to research college scholarships. Gain confidence and overcome unknown fears and anxiety around the interview process, and practice persuasive essay writing. Girls will have the opportunity to apply for the Lucile Miller Wright Scholarship, a Girls Inc National Scholarship. Girls Inc. is also a referral agency for the Daniels Fund.
