As kindergarten graduates we know these girls have unique needs for an all-day summer program that can be fun, engaging, and also prepare them for 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Girls will learn about themselves and how to work with others through physical activities. They participate in morning classes, break for lunch, and participate in afternoon electives. 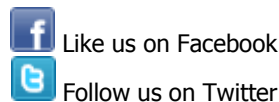
