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# Classes

Girls attend two classes a day for the summer. They participate in a morning class, break for lunch, and participate in an afternoon class. During special programs, all girls will participate in the same activity. If a girl participates in both summer sessions, she will benefit from all of the following:

### Sessions 1 and 2 Classes:

**Youth Biz:** Have you ever wanted to sell a product? Learn how! Design products, create marketplaces and learn about entrepreneurship in this fun and hands-on, business class.

**Imagine Science:** Imagine Science is a STEM program that uses technology and hands-on exploration to discover the connections between air, water & food and how we're affected by them.

**Express Yourself:** Creative expression gives girls the opportunity to share their feelings and thoughts, while developing new skills and having fun! Girls will explore creative activities and projects, such as painting, drawing, writing, making music, crafting and more!

**Basics of Cooking:** This class will teach girls about cooking and working with food. Girls will learn basic methods of cooking by doing fun, easy-to-perform cooking projects they will get to eat when they are finished.

### Special Programs:

Girls will have the chance to go off site and engage in fun adventures and activities. During these field trips girls will be encouraged to boldly participate in and try new things.
